WHAT WE OFFER

PE and School Sport

SJR will provide your school with a Lead Coach that can plan and deliver fun, engaging and inclusive sessions which achieve the outcomes of the national curriculum.

To enable consistency, we will provide the same coach for the start of each term, to allow staff and pupils to build a strong relationship, making them a valued addition to your team.

Teachers will have the opportunity to observe, join in, or work alongside our coaches to improve knowledge, confidence and skill of their PE teaching capabilities. We will provide lesson plans and schemes of work, and can offer a GTF

curriculum, all linking to your school and national curriculum looking to improve and develop your existing PE provision.

Staff CPD

How it works: Coaches will work alongside class teachers in a professional and supportive environment, with the aim to enhance their knowledge and confidence to deliver curriculum PE. This can be through observations, team teaching and meetings.

How the school benefits: Class teachers' knowledge, experience and confidence to deliver national curriculum PE will improve as they receive innovative ideas and practices across a variety of topics from our specialist coaches.

Extra-Curricular Clubs Breakfast Club | After-School Club

How it works: Choose between any of our extracurricular clubs, we can offer a variety of sport sessions to cater for the needs, interests and values of the school and its pupils.

How the school benefits: Children have access to additional PESSPA opportunities and further increase their skills and physical activity levels across different sports. These are great for discovering new interests, improving behaviour, boost confidence/ self-esteem or even increase female participation in sport.

Fixture Fridays

How it works: We will host friendly fixtures on selected Fridays each term at one of our three Home grounds. This will be across a variety

of sports, giving chance for your pupils to represent the school in a competitive yet low-stakes environment.

How the school benefits: This gives fantastic opportunity for pupils to represent the school in an external environment. Meaning they can put their skills and talents into practice against other schools and make some new friends along the way.

SJR Season Tickets **Breakfast Club | After-School Club**

How it works: As a partner school you will receive adult and child season tickets for SJRC. These can be used for all SJR home matches in the 2026/2027 season and each card will be delivered to the school to distribute how you see fit.

How the school benefits:
This enables your pupils to be out in the community, supporting their local team. This provides opportunity to be inspired by the players and gain a fantastic experience in what a matchday feels like free of charge.

SJR Matchday experience

How it works: On a chosen SJR matchday during the 2026/2027 season, chosen pupils will be invited for an elite matchday experience. This will include watching the match, meeting players, flag-bearing and playing on the pitch at half time.

How the school benefits: This will give pupils a memorable day in which we hope develops a life-long love and support for their local team. This also demonstrates more great relations between school pupils and their local club and community



Sowing the seeds

Six week morning taster

Includes: Mini-Kickers (EYFS/KS1) | Talent Development Centre (KS2) | Wildcats (KS1/KS2) | ABCs (EYFS/KS1/KS2)

How it works: Choose a course and a term in the academic year where one of our coaches will deliver 6 x 1 hour morning sessions in your school to showcase some of our specific focused sports provision. All sessions are packed with fun and inclusive activities whilst improving gross motor skills and fundamental movements.

How the school benefits:

These sessions give pupils the chance to access additional physical activity in a fun and engaging way during curriculum time whilst developing new interests and skills which can be utilised in and outside of the school environment. You choose the

course which you feel your pupils would benefit the most from.

The Bassetlaw Games

How it works: Schools who purchase a Premium Package will automatically be entitled to participate in our brand-new summer athletics event. Schools will partake in several events with pupils from KS2 at an organised athletics day held at Worksop College Ground. The day will be organised and run by our qualified coaches, whilst liaising with schools PE Leads.

How the school benefits: Pupils will experience an external sporting event and engage with other children their age. Participating in this positive enrichment activity will provide a greater understanding of health and wellbeing, working together as a group and personal development.



EVERYTHING COVERED

Pre and After-School Clubs

We can provide pre and after school clubs delivering a variety of sports in several capacities. We can offer the option to work with a school team of gifted and talented players in a specific sport, or provide an opportunity for those pupils who may not have the chance to be part of a school team to improve their abilities.

Our sessions are key-stage specific and can be used for a variety of other reasons such as behaviour, increase in confidence, enhance self-esteem or an increase in female sport participation.

Lunchtime Supervisor

An opportunity to utilise one of our experienced coaches on your lunchtime duties to engage with students on the playground. This can be through traditional playground games, team building games or organised sport sessions to keep all students active and engaged throughout lunchtimes.

Coaches can also support with other tasks such as setting up the hall, sanitising facilities / equipment and administering emergency aid.



nurturing talent

Playground Leaders

This course gives a brilliant introduction to pupils around leadership skills and provides them with the tools to be able to plan and deliver games which are suitable for school playgrounds. We look to work on personal skills such as communication, organisation and teamwork. The course can be used for gifted and talented students to further their development, or for target individuals to improve their self-esteem and confidence.

After completing this course, we recommend these pupils deliver playground games at lunch or break time to fellow pupils, enabling experience of planning and leadership to other pupils. This could be evidenced

by the promotion of actively taking part and leading structured activities during break and lunch times. This can be delivered as 1 x 6 hours, 3 x 2 hours or 6 x 1 hour sessions.

Mini Kickers

A course which is aimed at KSI children looking at teaching ABCs (Agility, Balance and Coordination) through using a football. It's a fun, engaging and inclusive activity which provides pupils with transferable skills for other sports, and offers pupils an alternative way to learn through enjoyable football sessions. This course is delivered in 6 x 1 hour sessions.

Wildcats

A specialist coach will come into your school to deliver a 6-week Wildcat programme which looks to introduce girls to the game of football. This is a girls only project in which they develop their football skills through 6 x 1 hour fun and sessions.

Stand Up - Speak Up

How it works: One of our qualified coaches will come into school to deliver this course to upper KS2 and can be delivered as 1 x 6 hours, 3 x 2 hours or 6 x 1 hour sessions. The course covers a different topic each session including themes such as: British Values, Racism, Diversity, Equality, and Identity. These sessions can be done as PSHE and/or PPA Cover.

How the school benefits:

Upper KS2 gain a wider knowledge of sensitive topics, as well as one of our coaches providing a safe space for discussions on topics that can sometimes be difficult to navigate.

Reward Fridays

How it works: One of our experienced coaches will come in to your school for 1 hour of delivery on a Friday to provide a fun session for challenging or Pupil Premium children, as a reward scheme for good behaviour throughout the week. These sessions can be heavily dictated by a sport or

activity the pupils want to participate in. The sessions are designed to be fun and enjoyable by way of motivating and rewarding positive decisions and behaviours.

How the school benefits:

This initiative provides schools with an additional behaviour management scheme, in which select pupils have an external motivation for positive behaviours. The pupils identified by your school can change every half term, so all children have the opportunity for the provision.

PPA Cover

We can provide a comprehensive school sports programme to cover your Planning, Preparation and Assessment which covers the 10% non-contact time your teachers take. We will assign you a coach that will plan and deliver high quality PE and School Sport sessions. These can be the conventional sports such as football, hockey and tag rugby, as well as unconventional sports such as tri-golf, new age curling and others, all linking to the national curriculum.

We will provide you with session plans and schemes of work, and offer the option of using our GTF curriculum of sport to ensure your pupils engage in a wide variety of sports. Wet weather options with inside space or classroom activities will be provided, which again will be linked with the national curriculum.

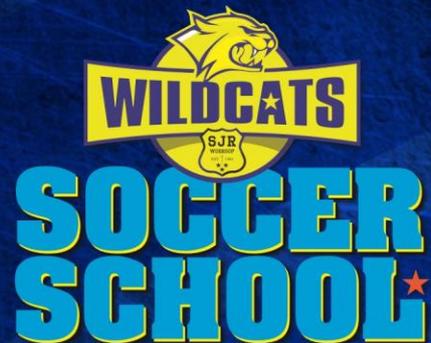
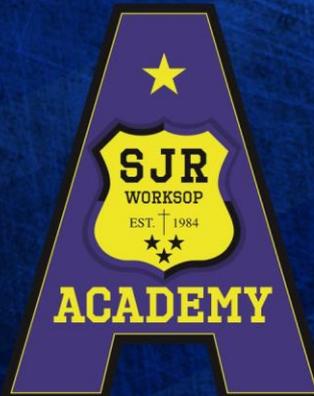
